# **General data on french livestock in 2023**

INTERBEV, the livestock and meat industry association gives us a view of the french livestock in 2023 :

- 50.900 breeders with more than 20 beef cows
- 43.000 breeders with more than 20 dairy cows
- 1.815 breeders with more than 50 yeal calves
- 125.400 jobs in other segments, including:

300 in marketing,

32.000 in slaughtering, cutting, and processing

85.100 in distribution

- 1.410.000 cattle exported live, including 1.020.000 young bulls and 38.200 calves
- 4.040.000 cattle slaughtered, including 1.030.000 calves
- 1.300.000 tonnes carcass equivalent, including 150.000 tonnes of veal
- 214.400 tonnes exported and... 363.400 tonnes imported
- A turnover of 11.1 billion Euros for meat and 1.5 billion Euros for live exports, with a trade surplus of 620 million Euros.

These figures reflect the importance of our sector in the french economy, which is worth highlighting during these times of great uncertainty regarding the political direction for our agriculture and livestock farming.

If we focus on Blonde d'Aquitaine, 430.000 blondes were on the national territory in 2023, a number that decreases every year, with a decrease that should be less this year.
